Over the years, your contributions have enabled 20 clinical projects and trials, with a noteworthy upcoming first-in-human trial of CAR T cell therapy on NETs in 2024. This groundbreaking trial was made possible through the investment of NETRF to Dr. Xianxin Hua and is a testament to the impact of your support in pushing the boundaries of NET research.

Your support has led to the granting or pending of 8 patents since 2017, showcasing our commitment to innovation. Notably, Dr. Roger Schibli's patent for manufacturing terbium-161 for theranostic application in NETs demonstrates the potential of your contributions in advancing technology and discoveries.
